Salary: 151 DKK/hour. Work hours: 8-12 hours/week on average.[1] **Rent:** 4.300 DKK/month (incl. utilities & furniture) + 6925 DKK (once per semester: administration fee).

Room size: 27m2 (gross areal) in a shared apartment Contract length: One year for both housing and work, with the possibility of extension.
